Most major subtitle formats are supported. Kodi can also search and download subtitles directly from full screen playback. 1 Changing subtitle settings during playback Audio options can be found under the gear icon. Home page: Video playback Various subtitle settings can be changed or have On/Off (default is on) via OSD (On Screen Display) while watching a movie by selecting the subtitle menu or audio options. Note: To make Kodi turn off subtitles by default: When playing a video, raise the display on the screen and select the audio options -> Turn off "subtitles" -> scroll down and select "save as default for all videos." 1.1 Settings Details Available options are: Enable subtitles Displays subtitles during playback of the current title. The subtitle tracks with the forced flag are not affected by this and should always show. Subtitle Soffset If the synchronization between display and subtitles is not correct, adjustments can be made here in milliseconds Subtitle Select which stream subtitle to display. If only one subtitle track is available, this option will not be available. Kodi will automatically select the subtitle language based on global settings. You can also choose to manually browse the subtitle file via OSD (On Screen Display). You can configure the way they are displayed through the Subtitles Settings, and you can adjust where they are displayed on the screen via the video calibration screen. Subtitles and video files must have the same name, for example: Video File: The Matrix.avi Subtitle: Matrix.srt 4.1 Kodi compressed subtitles also alsoVOBSUB compressed subtitles. Please note that the subtitles inside the RAR archive must still have the same name as the video file and requires the installation of the ADD-On RAR: See: RAR file support. Video File: La Matrix.avi Subtitle: The Matrix.Rar Where the Matrix.RAR contains the VOBSUB-FILE THE MATRIX.SUB and the Matrix.idx VOBSUB Index-file that has been compressed with RAR. If you want KODI to automatically turn on the packaged subtitles, you need to activate Search Subtitles in Rars option in Subtitle Settings. 4.2 Using KODI multilingual subtitles supports more than one external subtitle. This naturally is more useful when you have more than one subtitle file, (for example for multiple language). To use this feature you need to rename video files and subtitles as follows: Video File: The Matrix.avi Subtitle 1: The matrix.english.srt Subtitle 2: The matrix. French. Subtitle 3: Matrix. German.srt The point after the file name, but before the extension specifies the language (you can use anything here, mix numbers and letters or simply use one or the other). You can also mix subtitle formats, for example: Video File: Movie Name (2006) .avi Subtitle 1: Movie Name (2006). Chinese.idx Subtitle 1: Film Name (2006) .cinese.Sub Subtitle 2: Film Name (2006) Japanese.idx Subtitle 2: Film Name (2006) .giapponeese.Sub Subtitle 3: Film Name (2006). English. Subtitle 4: Name of the film (2006). French. Subtitle 5: Film name (2006) .German.ss 5 Advanced options 5.1 Adding fonts Additional fonts can be stored in the Kodi folder (a level under user data) at KODI / MEDIA / FONTS / 5.2 by increasing the delay interval for The subtitle adjustment Main page: AdvancedSettings.xml If you do not already have a advanced file .xml, it is very simple to do. Kodi uses this file for the settings and the advanced features that normal users should not change without first knowing what they do, as well as for experimental characteristics, etc. Create a simple text file (without rich text formatting, do not use .doc, etc.) and save it as advanced settings.xml. Make sure the file extension is ".xml" and not ".txt" or ".xml.txt". Cut and paste this into your new normal text file: 10 -> 10> ==> AudioDelAnyRange>
