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The meaning of disgruntled

Confused? This is what the word means in the world of cryptocurrency and finance, and why it is not lost. HODL = HOLD àHODLà is a cryptocurrency-related slang that stands for the word àholdà misspelled. It often refers to maintaining encryption assets you own for an extended period of time, even during a highly volatile market movement. àHodlà is intended to encourage people not to sell impulsively when a cryptocurrency drops dramatically or rises to become highly profitable to sell. àHOD It also acts as an acronym for "Hold on for care life." You will often see the term in various cryptocurrency forums and social media circles. Some influencers also encourage their followers to àchodlà various crypto tokens as part of their long-term strategy. The Origin of Hodl The word "hold" has been used in finance for a long time as part of the buy-and-hold strategy. This investment method involves buying a financial asset and holding it for an indefinite period of time. This is related to the fact that an investor should not be affected by short-term market movements and look to the long-term view. The term "HODL" comes from a post made in 2013 on Bitcointalk cryptocurrency forum shortly after a move by the Chinese government caused the price of Bitcoin to drop drastically within a day. An intoxicated member wrote a post titled "I AM HODLING" in response, detailing his overall fortune with the investment and his desire to keep his assets in the future. Shortly after that incident, the term "hodling" became common in the cryptocurrency enthusiast community. It has made its way into meme and social media and has become a way of signaling a token owner's desire to hang on their assets. àæehodlà and Cryptocurrencies The biggest reason why àæehodlà has become such a popular term is the general volatility of crypto prices. Currencies. Many cryptocurrency tokens, even relatively stable like Bitcoin and Ethereum, often have very volatile market fluctuations. The cost of these tokens can drop 100% one month and then rise 300% in the next few months. Cryptocurrency prices are also prone to whale movements (a term for people or organizations holding a very large amount of a particular token.) If even a whale decides to sell a particular token, they could tank the price entirely. àHODLà is considered as a way to combat these price swings. An asset-holder who follows the strategy does not sell, even when the market changes. Many people who "HODL" don't even pay close attention to the daily market movement of cryptoologists, preferring instead a long-term view of their tokens. Why people "Hodl"? Andreanicolini/Shutterstock.com One of the biggest reasons why people see "hodl" as a strategy is their belief in the underlying technology and the use case behind it. Bitcoin and most other cryptocurrencies rely on a technology called blockchain, which has many uses, including a way to make payments securely and anonymously over the Internet. Some people believe that Bitcoin is the future of all financial transactions rather than fiat currencies like dollars and euros. For many cryptocurrency owners, "hodling" is an intriguing prospect. The value of a single Bitcoin has gone from less than a dollar when it first came out over a decade ago to five digits in recent years. Despite the high volatility of the market, many cryptocurrency owners believe in the long-term financial outlook of Bitcoin and other tokens. At the same time, many other people believe that buying cryptocurrency is equivalent to gambling. Many people also believe that the values of cryptocurrencies are better when people buy and don't sell their tokens. That's why àehodlà is such a well-used term in the community à is often said to beginners who might be afraid to hold such a volatile asset. àHODLà fights what cryptographic users call àFUDà, which stands for àfear, uncertainty. FUD can include anything from naysayers to governments to negative pressures on the cryptocurrency problem. Using "HODL" is generally used only to refer to cryptocurrencies and not other assets. If you want to use the term àæehodl,à reserve it for conversations about these tokens or it could be misinterpreted. If you run into people who tell you about àæehodl,à there is a good chance that you've met cryptocurrency enthusiasts. Make sure you use good judgment when making critical financial decisions, such as buying a cryptocurrency. Never invest more than you can afford to lose. The answer is the same reason why "innovation" and "creativity" have become such dirty words in the modern era: It is too easy to misunderstand the meaning of all these words. Consider which images come to mind when you hear the word «innovation.» high-tech computers, glossy-white machines, or a list of bigger-life faces: Steve Jobs, Henry Ford, Elon Musk, Larry Page, or Bill Gates. These are all great innovators, no doubt, but they are not at all an accurate representation of what innovation is really about. Peggio still:à how often do I give articles plague your Facebook or Twitter feed, à punctuate your email box, or cover the first page of your favorite websites with titles on "how to hack innovation" or a guaranteed way to be more creative? Innovation is not one of these things, and it does not work as we are often told. There are repeatedly given false promises of what it means to innovate: immediate success, global The problem is that most innovations are not great, and most people on this planet do not fit the stereotypes behind them. This is especially true if you are not a white male living in the United States. In fact, innovation is a long, arduous and often invisible process to improve existing systems. That requires a diligent effort, taking risks and a certain level of serendipity. It is not romantic to say it, but it is true: innovation is work. The story of Steve Jobs is not that of a genius inventor who passed as a child in a garage of Palo Alto to global visionary in a few steps. The story of Steve Jobs is that of a man who worked hard, made a lot of great bets, made some mistakes along the way, and had the luck to seize opportunity when they came across his path. The same arc of history follows those we normally seek for lessons on innovation: a certain level of naiveness, the life of a novice, years of hard work and small victories, then (if they are lucky) a reflector on the media. For each story about how Steve Jobs or Elon Musk have crossed the boundaries and changed the world, there are thousands of other stories of small, quiet For example: William Kamkwamba has learned to build a windmill to feed his house by presenting himself in the library every day and reading of turbines. Eesha Khare invented asupercondenser that theoretically could charge phones and other devices in seconds. seconds.do not even mention some of the greatest innovators in history whose names you may not be so familiar with. Like Emmy Noether, who led the discoveries of physics and abstract algebra and whom Albert Einstein once called "the most significant creative mathematical genius." Claude Shannon added binary code to circuit designs to lay the foundation for data storage and transmission, which continues to work on our smartphones, computers and televisions. Clair Cameron Patterson is given the task of developing a way to calculate the age of the Earth, do you have any ideas?But these stories aren't as popular as Elon Musk or Steve Jobs. Why? Because they don't fit the story of the lonely, white, male genius who is so prominent in Western culture. We often prefer the romantic version of innovation, which promises high levels of ingenuity and rewards over the more accurate representation of small steps and only small hints of recognition.As a result, your beliefs about what it means to innovate (who can do it and how it is done) have been distorted. Now, when you read articles on how to hack innovation or how to be more creative at night, you come across false promises and disappointment.The reality is that creativity and innovation are going to require you to work for them. Not much work necessarily hard, but work nonetheless, and a lot of it over time, towards a specific goal set.To quote Craig Lambert, writer and editor for Harvard Magazine, from his book Mind Over Water: "Success isn't a big thing; it's every little thing, accomplished on a daily basis.

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
